A World in Transition

Political and economic crises, geopolitical fragmentation, and new alliances signal the dawn of a new yet uncertain era, driven by a recurring theme over the past five years: energy security.

In this context, natural resources play a crucial role. They determine energy control, availability, and, consequently, economic development and stability.

Some of these resources are vital and are subject to competition among global powers, with all the implications that entails.



A revival and new policy for the mining Sector in Algeria

Through its revitalization and a more attractive mining law that draws lessons from the past, Algeria is redefining its role and approach in this evolving global landscape, particularly regarding strategic mineral resources.

It is with this vision that the upcoming **International Conference and Exhibition on Mines and Quarries, MICA'2025**, has been designated as a major event—a platform to showcase Algeria's mining potential and the State's strategy to develop it, integrate it into the national economy, and promote partnership opportunities.

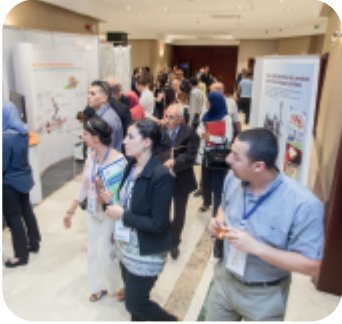
1. A Dedicated Space for National and International Mining Stakeholders

It will foster exchanges of expertise, solutions, and innovations addressing strategies, partnership policies, technologies, and development programs in response to current and future challenges.



2- A Space to Learn About the Restructuring of the Mining Sector

Participants will gain insights into the **sector's restructuring, its strategy, and the provisions of the new mining law**, which aims to boost mining activities and attract investments.



3- A Space to Showcase and Discuss Algeria's Mining Ambitions

This space will highlight structural projects (Iron, Phosphate, Lead-Zinc) designed to move Algeria away from a rent-based economy by developing and maximizing the country's vast mining potential. It will also address the growing demand for various mineral resources across key sectors such as industry, construction (quarries), and agriculture (fertilizers).



4- A Space for Algeria's Strategic Mineral Development Strategy

Given Algeria's undeniable potential in strategic minerals, this space will focus on the nation's approach to meeting the exponentially increasing global demand in the coming decades. With an estimated one-fifth of critical minerals still undiscovered, these resources will be crucial for energy production, the electronics industry, AI data centers, as well as the military and space industries.



5- A Space for New Technologies and Artificial Intelligence

This area will present cutting-edge technologies and the integration of artificial intelligence to address key challenges in mining, including:

- o Enhancing exploration success
- o Improving deposit profitability
- o Ensuring environmental protection
- o Safeguarding the health of mining sector workers



6- A Space for Networking and Collaboration

Bringing together public and private organizations, investors, operators, subcontractors, equipment and technology producers, universities, researchers, and human resource trainers, this space will focus on preparing the workforce for the future in an increasingly complex mining industry.

The event will serve as a strategic meeting point for industry players, offering opportunities for knowledge-sharing, business networking, and collaboration to drive innovation and growth in Algeria's mining and quarrying sector.

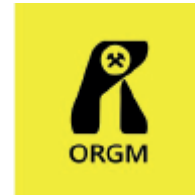
